

BANKES CUP

Two qualifying rounds of 18 holes strokeplay. The best 8 net aggregate scores qualify for matchplay, any ties to be decided on better second round, then on count-back of second round.

Automatic draw for matchplay.

Winner is awarded the Bankes Cup and a voucher, runner-up is awarded a voucher.

Conditions

1. Method of Entry

Add name to entry sheet online or enter online from computer in hallway (available 4 weeks prior to competition), draw done on Mondays. For late entries/withdrawals contact Match Secretary in first instance for assistance. The draw will be e-mailed by Match Secretary and posted on the notice board in the Ladies Changing Room.

To enter Friday competitions – arrange your own partners and tee times. Any player who has held or who holds a valid handicap may mark a card.

For match play competitions – add name to draw sheet before closing date, no late entries allowed.

2. Intention to Play

Indicate intention to play by entering name in Pro Shop (stroke play only).

3. Transportation

Any player may use a buggy for any competition (see Decision 33-1/8 in the Decisions Book and Appendix 1, Part C, Paragraph 9 of Rules).

4. Suspension/Abandonment of Play

For stroke play - play will be abandoned if course deemed unplayable. The competition will then be rescheduled (usually the next Tuesday).

For match play – if the course becomes unplayable, play will be suspended and resumed at a mutually agreed date/time at the point of suspension, match score to stand.

5. Distance Measuring Devices

Tain Golf Club Local Rule permits the use of distance measuring devices only, but not the use of measuring devices used for land gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.

6. Tied Game – Match Play

By agreement between competitors – either sudden death or replay (18 holes).

7. Organising Match Play Competitions

All competitors are responsible for ensuring matches are played by the due date. No extension will be granted. If a ties is not play by due date, all competitions will be disqualified.

8. Players winning more than one prize

A player may only win one prize in any competition. The prize with the greater value takes precedence. If both prizes have the same value, a scratch prize taken precedence over a handicap prize.

9. Handicaps for Multiple Round Competitions

Competitors play off their correct, valid handicap at the date of competition.

The only exception is the 2-Day Ladies Open where competitors will play off the same handicap for the two qualifying rounds.

10. Disputes

Any dispute which cannot be resolved by the competitors should be brought to the attention of the Lady Captain ASAP. If the Captain is unavailable, competitors should approach a Committee Member.

11. Open to all Ladies and girls who hold a valid handicap, 18 holes strokeplay.

12 Prizes to be awarded at the Prizegiving.
