

JUNIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

Format

For junior or juvenile members aged under 18 on the first of January of year in which competition is played.

One qualifying round of 18 holes strokeplay played from the Medal (White), Box (Yellow) or Junior (Blue) for Boys and Red Tees for girls. Girls receive the difference in the gents and ladies CSS's added to their handicaps.

The number of entries will determine the number of qualifiers and matchplay rounds.

If entries permit the 8 competitors with the best gross score after the qualifying round will qualify for the Club Championship. If entries permit the 8 competitors with the best nett score (after the top 8 gross scores have been removed) after the round will qualify for the Handicap Club Championship.

Ties to be decided on a count back, better inward half, last 6 holes, last 3 holes etc.

Play will be in threes

An automatic draw will be done after close of play and displayed on the notice board with dates and times that the matches have to be played on.

The matchplay rounds will be played on the Monday, Wednesday and Friday evenings directly following the qualifying round. These times will not be changed under any circumstances and any competitor not available for any of the match play rounds may play in the qualifying round for handicap purposes but must clearly mark "non-qualifier" on their card.

The winner of the Club Championship will receive the Lindsey Anderson Trophy on the day and again at the prizegiving along with a prize.

The winner of the Handicap Club Championship will receive the Coaches Cup on the day and again at the prizegiving along with a prize.

No adult caddies are allowed in junior competitions.

Conditions

1. Method of Entry

Online entry will be available 1 month before the date of the competition.

Juniors will be able to book tee times online up until the day of play. A draw will then be made in the pro shop prior to play.

2. Intention to Play

Indicate intention to play by entering name in Pro Shop.

4. Suspension/Abandonment of Play

Play will be abandoned if course deemed unplayable. The competition will then usually be rescheduled at a later date.

For match play – if the course becomes unplayable, play will be suspended and resumed at later date/time at the point of suspension, match score to stand.

5. Distance Measuring Devices

Tain Golf Club permits a player to obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.

6. Tied Game – Match Play

Ties to be decided by sudden death.

11. Disputes

Any dispute which cannot be resolved by the competitors should be brought to the attention of the Secretary or Captain ASAP. If they are unavailable, competitors should approach the Professional.

12. Open to all junior or juvenile members aged under 18 on the first of January of year in which competition is played who hold a valid handicap.

14. Prizes to be awarded on the day of the final and at the Prizegiving.
