

JUNIOR BANK OF SCOTLAND CUP

Format

This is a 2-ball foursomes matchplay knockout competition.

For junior or juvenile members (boys and girls) aged under 18 on the first of January of year in which competition is played.

A draw will be done to determine the pairings.

Matches to be arranged by the participants.

The initiative taken for the arrangement is up to both parties equally.

Matches have to be played by the due date.

Play is from the medal (White), box (Yellow) or (Blue) tees for boys and red tees for girls

Handicap allowance – ½ difference between aggregate handicaps of each side

The girls receive the difference in the gents and ladies CSS's added to their handicaps

No adult caddies are allowed in junior competitions.

Conditions

1. **Method of Entry**

Enter by putting name on entry sheet on junior noticeboard, including handicap.

There will be no late entries once the draw has been done.

2. **Suspension/Abandonment of Play**

For match play – if the course becomes unplayable, play will be suspended and resumed at a mutually agreed date/time at the point of suspension, match score to stand.

3. **Tied Game – Match Play**

By agreement between competitors - either sudden death or replay (18 holes).

4. **Organising Match Play Competitions**

All competitors are responsible for ensuring matches are played by the due date. No extension will be granted. If a tie is not played by due date, all competitors will be disqualified

5. **Disputes**

Any dispute which cannot be resolved by the competitors should be brought to the attention of the Secretary or Captain ASAP. If they are unavailable, competitors should approach the Professional.

6. **Open to all Girls and Boys (aged under 18 on the first of January of year in which competition is played) who hold a valid handicap, 18 holes strokeplay.**

7. **Prizes to be awarded at the prizegiving.**
