

GENTS 4 – DAY OPEN

Format

Two qualifying rounds of 18 holes strokeplay played from the Medal (White) Tees on Monday and Tuesday.

The 16 competitors with the best gross aggregate scores after the two rounds will qualify for the McVitie & Price Cup.

The 16 competitors with the best nett aggregate scores (after the top 16 gross scores have been removed) after the two rounds will qualify for Stirling Cup.

The 32 competitors with the next best nett aggregate scores after the two rounds will qualify for either the Munro Rose Bowl or the Teddy Brookes Trophy. The 16 competitors with the lowest handicaps will qualify for the Munro Rose and the next 16 for the Teddy Brookes Trophy.

Ties to be decided on a count back, better inward half, last 6 holes, last 3 holes etc.

An automatic draw will be done after close of play on Tuesday and displayed on the notice board with dates and times that the matches have to be played on. The club shall also display the draw on this website.

2 matchplay rounds will be played on the Wednesday with the Semi finals and Finals played on the Thursday. On the Wednesday there will also be a consolation round for non-qualifiers who will contest the Consolation Cup.

If any of the qualifying rounds has to be cancelled due to inclement weather there will still be the same number of qualifiers for the matchplay taken from one qualifying round.

The times for the matchplay will not be changed under any circumstances (unless due to problems with inclement weather) and any competitor not available for any of the match play rounds may play in the qualifying rounds for handicap purposes but must clearly mark "non-qualifier" on their card.

During the qualifying rounds there will also be trophies awarded as follows

J A Ross Cup - Leading local qualifier H/C

John Fraser Salver – Leading Non-Local qualifier H/C

Hugh Ross Trophy – Pairs, best aggregate nett (Mondays round only)

Ross Gilmour Shield – Seniors, best aggregate nett, 2 rounds

Conditions

1. Method of Entry

ONLINE BOOKING IS AVAILABLE FOR THIS COMPETITION. TEE TIME BLOCKS WILL BE HOURLY ie 7.30 - 8.30 etc AND A DRAW WILL BE MADE FROM ALL THE NAMES ENTERED. ACTUAL PLAYING TIMES DO NOT REFLECT THE TIMES BOOKED ONLINE.

Entry forms are also available to download from this website and from the office.

For late entries/withdrawals contact the Office or Pro Shop if on the day.

Draw will be done after the closing date.

2. Intention to Play

Indicate intention to play by entering name in Pro Shop.

3. Suspension/Abandonment of Play

Play will be abandoned if course deemed unplayable.

For match play – if the course becomes unplayable, play will be suspended and resumed at later date/time at the point of suspension, match score to stand.

4. Tied Game – Match Play

Ties to be decided by sudden death.

5. Handicaps for Multiple Round Competitions

Competitors play off their correct, valid handicap at the date of competition. Competitors will play off the same handicap for the two qualifying rounds, handicaps to be subsequently adjusted for match play according to their correct handicap at the time of playing the match.

6. Disputes

Any dispute which cannot be resolved by the competitors should be brought to the attention of the Secretary or Captain ASAP. If they are unavailable, competitors should approach the Professional.

7. Open to all Gents and Boys who hold a competition handicap.

8. Prizes to be awarded at the prizegiving after the conclusion of the finals.
