

HUGH MACKENZIE SENIOR OPEN

Format

Competitors must be 50 years old or over on the day of the competition
18 holes strokeplay played from the Box (Yellow) Tees.

Age Group Categories 50 – 59, 60 – 69 & 70 and over

Ties to be decided on a count back, better inward half, last 6 holes,
last 3 holes etc.

Play will be in threes

The winner will receive the Hugh MacKenzie Trophy



Conditions

1. Method of Entry

ONLINE BOOKING IS AVAILABLE FOR THIS COMPETITION. TEE TIME BLOCKS WILL BE HOURLY ie 8-9 etc AND A DRAW WILL BE MADE FROM ALL THE NAMES ENTERED. ACTUAL PLAYING TIMES DO NOT REFLECT THE TIMES BOOKED ONLINE.

Entry forms are also available to download from this website and from the office.

For late entries/withdrawals contact the Office or Pro Shop if on the day.

Draw will be done on the Tuesday before the competition.

2. Intention to Play

Indicate intention to play by entering name in Pro Shop.

3. Suspension/Abandonment of Play

Play will be abandoned if course deemed unplayable. The competition will then usually be rescheduled at a later date.

4. Players winning more than one prize

A player may only win one prize in this competition. The prize with the greater value takes precedence. If both prizes have the same value, a scratch prize takes precedence over a handicap prize unless it is the winner of the trophy.

5. Handicaps

Competitors play off their correct, valid handicap at the date of competition.

6. Disputes

Any dispute which cannot be resolved by the competitors should be brought to the attention of the Secretary or Captain ASAP. If they are unavailable, competitors should approach the Professiona.

7. Open to all Gents aged 50+ who hold a competition handicap.

8. Prizes to be awarded at the prizegiving on the day after the conclusion of play.
